3 ways to keep your kids safe

When you get a prescription medicine:

-  **Lock it up.** Always store medicines in a lockbox or locked cabinet.
-  **Count your pills.** Keep track of how many you take — that way you'll know if any are missing.
-  **Return** leftover medicine to a drug collection box.

In **Franklin County** and the **North Quabbin Region**, you can find collection boxes at police stations in Ashfield, Athol, Bernardston, Buckland, Deerfield, Erving, Greenfield, Leverett, Orange, Shelburne Falls, Sunderland, Turners Falls, and Whately.
