

## **FY18 Opioid Task Force Community Grants Program**

Through support from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, administered by the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, the Opioid Task Force (Task Force) of Franklin County and the North Quabbin Region is offering grants to help the Task Force meet its mission to help reduce opioid and heroin addiction, prevent overdose deaths, and improve the quality of life in our community.

<u>Eligible Applicants:</u> Schools, town/city and county government agencies, non-profit, volunteer or community-based groups, and faith-based communities located in the Franklin County/North Quabbin region.

Maximum grant amount: Up to \$5,000. Exceptions may apply.

<u>Application Deadlines and Grant Period</u>: Application deadline: **Friday, December 8, 2017, 5 PM** for the grant period of **January 1, 2018** - **June 30, 2018**.

#### **Criteria for Selection:**

- Project or program will address one or more of the Task Force's priority areas: prevention, intervention, treatment, and/or recovery.
- Demonstration and/or evidence of collaboration with other partners.
- Description of support for proposed project or program within the targeted community or region.
- Demonstrated experience and knowledge of proposed project or program to meet identified need.
